NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (2013-2016), and the Procedural Rules (PR) and Class Rules for Intercollegiate Sailing Competition 2013-2016, except as any of these are modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. RRS Appendix P will be in effect, as modified by PR 32.

3. FORMAT

- 3.1. A single round is scheduled. Competitors will switch boats after every two races.
- 3.2. Each division will rotate through three fleets of boats in accordance with the printed rotation.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Sailing Instructions will be available on Tech Score and posted on the Official Notice Board.

5. ICSA REPRESENTATIVE

5.1. Greg Wilkinson (Boston College) will serve as the ICSA Representative.

6. **BOATS & EQUIPMENT**

6.1. Laser Performance FJs and Laser Performance Z420s will be provided for all competitors.

7. SAFETY

7.1. At the discretion of the Regatta Chairman, dry suits or wet suits may be required. Notice will be given orally and on the Official Notice Board on the morning of each day of competition.

8. COACHING

8.1. PR 19 will apply. Coach boats may be provided.

9. COMPETITOR ONLY ZONE

9.1. The second floor of Jacobs Rock and all floating docks will be Competitor Only Zones. Allowed in these zones will be competitors, coaches, officials, and CGA staff only. Signs will direct other regatta attendees to spectating locations.

10. WATER AND WATER BOTTLES

10.1. The water at Jacobs Rock is non-potable. Competitors should bring their own reusable water bottles and larger quantity containers for re-filling.
