5. Format: A/B Division. Sailing Instructions will be provided on site and to all registered teams.
6. Rotations: Rotations will take place from shore side docks
7. Registration: Teams must confirm attendance. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements and must currently be actively enrolled in the club or varsity sports program at their respective institutions. There will be 5 berths provided for SAISA, 5 berths provided for MAISA. A waiting list will be maintained and berths filled by conference on a rotating basis.
8. Food & Water: Complimentary breakfast will be provided for all sailors on Saturday morning courtesy of NC State Sailing. A lunch break will be provided or offered on off rotation. Sailors will need to bring their own lunches.

Please use only refillable containers for water as we strongly consider our environmental impact as a team and program. This will be a certified Clean Regatta. No disposable water bottles will be allowed. There will be stations provided to refill water bottles.
