1 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Procedural Rules, and the sailing instructions.

2 Schedule

No Sunday start after	1500

Note: the boathouse will not open before 1000 for early arrivals. Early arriving sailors can help carry boats out.

3 Sailing Instructions will be available via Tech Score by Friday

4 Format

Combined divisions with 22 Larks racing at once.

5 Courses

5.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate)

5.2 Course 5 (W-L-W-L-W with offset and gate) may be used as well.

5.3 Course 6 is also a possibility

5.4 If windy enough, G (W-R-R-W-L) or O (W-R-R-W-L-W) may be used with no offset nor gate.

6 Larks, built in 2016 by Whitecap Composites are beautiful; keep them that way. Adjusting the shroud pins between races is permitted except that no spare clevis pins and cotter rings will be supplied if you lose any.

7 Protests

7.1 Forms are available in the office and must be filled during the first offset after the incident.

7.2 Protests will be heard in the Crystal Lake Room (conference room)

8 Prizes for all is the opportunity to sail the coolest boats in all of college sailing.

9 Boathouse Use

9.1 Gear bags and changing of clothes are not allowed on the top floor.

9.2 Food is allowed on the top floor but be neat.
