4 Format

A and B fleets will rotate on the dock every 2 races.

5 Courses

- 5.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate).
- 5.2 Courses 5 and 6 may be used as well. For course 5, the finish is between mark 1 and the committee boat.
- 5.4 In the event of strong winds, additional courses incorporating reach legs may be posted on the notice board.

6 Equipment

- 6.1 Larks, built in 2016 by Whitecap Composites, are beautiful; keep them that way.
- 6.2 Adjusting the shroud pins between races is permitted except that no spare clevis pins and cotter rings will be supplied if they are dropped off the dock.

7 Protests

- 7.1 Forms are available upon request and must be filled during the first offset after the incident.
- 7.2 Protests may be heard in the Crystal Lake Room (conference room), or outdoors.

8 Prizes

All participants will be awarded with the opportunity to sail the fastest boats in all of college sailing.
