# NOTICE OF RACE

RULES:

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Procedural Rules and the Sailing Instructions.

1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) is SAISA in conjunction with Florida Institute of Technology.

ELIGIBILITY:

2.1. Any SAISA school that is in good standing with SAISA and ICSA.

2.2. Any team may bring a maximum of 4 boats.

ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:

Each team if no longer attending must drop by at least 2 weeks prior. This means the drop deadline is 9/4/2023 or earlier.

BOATS:

4.1 All boats in the Women's Championship must be Radial Rig Lasers following all ILCA6 class rules. Open Championship must be Full Rig Lasers following all ILCA7 class rules.
4.2. Boats must be supplied by the competitor (Bring your own Boat).
