RULES

The Racing Rules of Sailing, and the ICSA Procedural and Class rules, will govern the regatta.

LOCATION

Stanford Boathouse in Redwood City CA.

FORMAT

The Bryson Women's is a A and B combined division regatta. The Gold/Silver will be two single division regattas. An attempt of 14 races in each regatta will be made. There will be no rotation, teams will be assigned boats at the competitors meeting Saturday.

ENTRY

The fee is \$20.00 per boat for Gold/Silver and \$20.00 per school for Bryson women's that needs to be paid Saturday morning at registration. **All checks can be made to Stanford University.** The Gold/ Silver regatta will be a seeded regatta with a committee determining who is in Gold and Silver. All schools must submit their skippers on the PCCSC google doc by the Tuesday before the regatta. The Bryson women's is open to all women's teams with PCCSC eligibility but a limit of 9 teams will be accepted.

BOATS

Both fleets of FJ's and z420's may be used in the rotation for the event. All boats are provided. The stay masters for the z420's maybe adjusted throughout the regatta
