

Reminders on the care of fleet if you please

- Stay out of the boat until it is floating in the water.
- Raise main and jib only when you are ready to leave the dock.
- Enter and exit the boats from the cockpit
 - Hold the shroud and step into the cockpit
- Rudders remain off whenever the boats are on the dock (postponements, lunch breaks)
- Tie sail bags to cradle before going afloat.

End of the day

- Lay rudders in bottom of boat with blade facing toward bow
- Shock-cords released, centerboards up to the maximum, plugs out, cradle tie-downs thru the U-bolt on chain plate.
- Sails get rolled with main leech to jib luff and vice versa

Crew docks are EVIL—no dinghies should go near them!
