**Notice of Race**

**1. Rules**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the ICSA procedural rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.  
1.2 US sailing prescriptions RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

**2. Eligibility and Entry**

- 2.1 This regatta is open to all ICSA sailing teams.

**3. Schedule of Events**

**4. Sailing Instructions**

- 4.1 Sailing instructions shall be made available at check in.

**5. Format**

- 5.1 The Regatta shall be sailed in one fleet, divided into A and B divisions.

**6. Venue**

- 6.1 The racing area shall be on the James River, to the south of the Kingsmill Marina.  
6.2 The courses may be any variation of a triangular or other course and may include a leeward gate. Course diagrams will be included in the sailing instructions.

**7. Boats and Equipment.**

- 7.1 FJ's and sails shall be provided by the William and Mary sailing team. Boats will be sailed as provided except the mainsheet may be rigged 3:1 as opposed to 4:1.

**8. Scoring**

- 8.1 3 races in each division shall constitute a series.  
8.2 The regatta shall be scored in accordance with ICSA procedural Section B.

**9. Coaching/ Spector Boats.**

- 9.1 Coach and Spector Boats shall not be provided.  
9.2 Coach or Spector boats must stay well clear of the racing area at all times, and shall have no contact with a competitor during the course of a race, except when rendering assistance under RRS 1.1, or as directed by the race committee.

**10. Disclaimer**

- 10.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustain in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**11. Further Information**

- 11.2 Teams will be responsible for their own food. Most food options are at least a 10-minute drive away, thus teams are encouraged to bring food to the venue in advance of racing.
