1 <u>Rules</u>

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the <u>2021-2024 RRS</u> and the <u>2021-2024 ICSA</u> <u>Procedural Rules</u>.
- 1.2 Races will not be umpired.
- 1.3 Drysuits may be required at the discretion of the Race Committee.

2 <u>Notices to Competitors</u>

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board (white board).

3 <u>Schedule of Races</u>

4 <u>Format</u>

- 4.1 Two full round-robins are planned, to be sailed in 12 Larks and 6 FJs.
- 4.2 The format thereafter shall be determined based on timing and conditions, but all scores will carry forward.

5 <u>The Course</u>

The course will be a Starboard digital "N," staring with a windward leg, followed by a port reach, then a run, then a starboard reach, and a final windward leg.

6 <u>Marks</u>

Marks are mast buoys displaying flags numbered "1" (yellow), "2" (light blue), "3" (red), "4" (green), "S," and "F" (both orange). "G" (purple) will serve as a spare mark.

7 <u>The Start</u>

- 7.1 Races will be started using Appendix Q, Sound Signal Starting System.
- 7.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the starboard end committee boat and a mast buoy at the port end displaying flag "S" (orange).

8 <u>The Finish</u>

The finish line will be between a staff displaying a white flag on the starboard end committee boat and a mast buoy at the port end displaying flag "F" (orange).

9 <u>Protests</u>

Protest forms are available in the office/kitchenette on the upper floor. The finish boat should be notified of any protests immediately following the last boat's finish. Protests shall be filed with the scorekeeper within 30 minutes of the end of any round-robin or sail-off round. Be prepared for three-minute justice with coaches and competitors as judges.
