### Sailing Instructions

**1. RULES-** This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, the ICSA Procedural Rules, and these Sailing Instructions. The organizing authority is the Intercollegiate Sailing Association of North America in conjunction with host UNH.

#### APPENDIX T-1 PENALTIES AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT

The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 while racing. However, when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.'

**2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS-** Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the second floor of the Tufts boathouse.

**3. SCHEDULE-** Fifteen races per Division are scheduled, of which three (3) races per Division shall be required to constitute a series as provided in the ICSA PR.

**5. Format-** One division shall race at a time. The regatta format will be a single round robin.

**5. ROTATION-** The rotation of boats will be in accordance with the provided rotation available on Tech Score. Competitors may only pull up boats on the dock during the rotation period with the permission of the race committee. Please ease the vang between races and **do not land** at the dock during a set unless receiving prior permission from the RC.

**6. STARTING AND FINISHING LINES; STARTING SYSTEM-** Races will be started in accordance with PR 18. Whistles will be used instead of a sound system. The starting line will be between a staff on the Race Committee Signal Boat and the water's edge (course side) of the starting mark.

7. **PROTESTS**- Protests shall comply with the ICSA Procedural Rules. Protest forms are available on the second floor of the Tufts boathouse and delivered to the NEISA representative. Hearings will be held as soon as possible during the off set with all participating school's coaches assisting.
  8. **BOATS** - The standing rigging may not be adjusted.
  9. **COACHING** - ICSA PR 19 will apply, and all Coaches shall remain ashore.
  10. **NEISA REPRESENTATIVE**- the Race Committee shall appoint a Representative who shall assist in ensuring the quality and fairness of the competition. This representative shall act as a liaison between the teams in attendance and the Race Committee Chairman. The rep for this event is: (will be announced at competitors meeting on Saturday).
