



## Notice of Race

### 2019 Kilpatrick Regatta 23 October 2021

#### 1. Hosts

The 2021 Kilpatrick Regatta will be co-hosted by the University of Central Oklahoma Sailing Club and the Oklahoma City Boat Club.

#### 2. Location

Oklahoma City Boat Club, Lake Hefner, 9101 Lake Hefner Parkway, Oklahoma City, OK 73120. Racing will be conducted on Lake Hefner from the Oklahoma City Boat Club.

#### 3. Boats

The regatta will be sailed in 420's supplied by the hosts.

#### 4. Eligibility

All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements, including fall 2021 submission of team's Covid Attestation and Declaration of Adherence forms to ICSA and SEISA.

#### 5. Rules & Format

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2020-2023 and the ICSA Procedural Rules. All teams are required to wear uniforms as described in ICSA PR 13(e). This regatta will be a 2-division, rotational event. Please note that if three or fewer teams attend, then both divisions may be combined. Also, be aware COVID-19 protocols may prevent boat rotation. The boat rotation (sail number) will be announced during the Competitor's Meeting. Sailing instructions will be available on Techscore. Finally, all competitors and guests will be expected to follow COVID-19 guidelines during the competition.

**6. COVID-19 Guidelines :** Teams are reminded practice safe social distancing procedures and follow ISCA COVID-19 guidelines.

- The Centerboard Building and nearby area, including the pathway to the dock, is designated as the Field of Play. Only competitors and regatta personnel are allowed in that area.
- All individuals (regardless of vaccination status) shall wear a face covering while indoors at the regatta.
- The changing area and restrooms are in the OCBC clubhouse. Please make every effort to have only one team in the changing rooms at any time.
- All large meetings that need to be held prior to or following the event will be conducted outdoors, following social distancing procedures between teams.

#### 7. Schedule

Saturday, October 5

9:00 a.m. – Check-in followed by Competitor's Meeting

10:00 a.m. – Warning Signal for Race 1

No warning signal will occur after 5:00 p.m. This is a one-day regatta, so there will be no racing on Sunday. Results of regatta will follow conclusion of racing and de-rigging of boats.

**9. Oklahoma City Boat Club Restrictions**

No pets, fireworks, drones, or open fires are allowed on OCBC property.

OCBC is committed to preventing the spread of zebra mussels and asks all boat owners to clean their bilges and trailers when coming from another lake to Lake Hefner, and again when leaving Lake Hefner going to another lake.
