## NOTICE OF RACE

## 1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024.1.2 The Intercollegiate Sailing Association (ICSA) Procedural Rules for Intercollegiate Sailing Competition and the Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules will apply.

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 All collegiate ICSA teams are invited to compete. SEISA and MCSA teams will be accepted first and others as equipment is available. Contact the Regatta Coordinator for information on boat availability.
2.2 Eligible teams must enter not later than Friday September 30th, 2022 by registering the event online through by confirming to <u>KUsailing@gmail.com</u>

The Kansas Sailing Foundation <u>https://www.kansasyouthsailing.com</u> regatta website will have entry forms, waivers, and logistical details.

3 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS
Saturday, October 8th
0900 - 0945 Registration, Check in / rigging of boats
1000 Mandatory Competitor meeting. Races to follow.

Sunday, October 9th
0830 - 0900 Breakfast, rigging of boats
1000 First Warning Signal. Races to follow.
1330 No A Division race will start after this time. Awards to follow as soon as possible after the final race.

## 4 FORMAT

4.1 A round robin (A Division and B Division) will be sailed. Each division of each school shall sail the same boat for two or three races in a row, and then the other division will race the next boat in the rotation.4.2 Racing will continue until the round robin is complete or the time limit is reached, whichever occurs first.

4.3 The regatta will supply matched 420s.

4.4 Teams with additional sailors may enter additional crews as equipment permits.

#### **5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available no later than 0930 on Saturday October 8th.

#### 6 VENUE

The venue will be Perry Yacht Club. Races will be run on the waters in front of the club unless the race committee directs otherwise. Races will be visible from the shore. Competitors will have access to the club facilities between Friday October 7th and Sunday October 9th.

## 7 FEES

The required fee for the regatta is \$10 per person. Which includes equipment (c420), club access to tent camping or RV hook up and meals provided Saturday (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and Sunday (Breakfast and Lunch).

## 8 COACHING, TEAM MEMBERS AND SUPPORT BOATS

Coaches and extra sailors are welcome however limited equipment or support boats. Spectators and coaches may view the races from the club or from spectator boats (as available).

## **9 COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS**

Each team shall bring enough clothing and equipment to be properly attired for the conditions for sailing at one time, including US Coast Guard approved (Type 3) Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs). The PFDs must be available for inspection at registration.

Teams shall also have consistent identification (pinnies or jerseys) that go over life jackets for easy identification of teams. (Football, basketball, and custom jerseys are acceptable as long as they match).

## **10 PRIZES**

The Rock Chalk / Big 12 Trophy will be awarded to the winning team. This perpetual trophy is maintained by Perry Yacht Club. A bar engraved with the year and the name of the winning college is added to the permanent plaque maintained by Perry Yacht Club.

10.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first, second and third place schools overall.

## **11 SPECTATORS**

Spectators are welcome to attend, if they do attend and camp and desire meals with competitors they will be charged \$10 as well. Spectators will be able to view racing from the shore.

## **12 HOUSING**

There is camping available on site for either tents or vehicles or pull behind campers. There are motels in Lawrence, Kansas approximately 30 minutes from the regatta site.
