

NOTICE of RACE

The Organizing Authority (OA) and host is Texas A&M Sailing.

1. RULES

1.1. This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), ICSA Procedural Rules for Intercollegiate Sailing Competition (ICSA PR), and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the competitors' meeting and on the event notice board found online at scores.college.sailing.org.

3. CREWS, BOATS, & EQUIPMENT

- 3.1. The event will be sailed on z420s provided by the host.
- 3.2. Boats will be rotated throughout the regatta, in accordance with the Sailing Instructions

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. All team briefings and skippers' meetings will take place in the sailing compound in which the boats are sheltered.

5. VENUE & PARKING

- 5.1. The Racing Area will be the Lake Bryan Municipal Park (8200 Sandy Point Rd. Bryan, Texas 77807)
- 5.2. Parking is available adjacent to the launch area.
- 5.3. Lake Bryan charges a \$5.00 entrance fee per vehicle.

6. COACHING

6.1. On the water spectator access for coaches and alternates will be made available as space allows.

7. SAFETY

- 7.1. All teams must be eligible to compete in ICSA competitions and comply with the most recent ICSA Medical Guidance for ICSA Competition.
- 7.2. Visiting teams and coaches are expected to provide their own type III PFDs.
- 7.3. PFDs must be donned prior to boarding and closed toed shoes must be always worn aboard USNA vessels.
