**1 Rules**

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Procedural Rules, and the sailing instructions.

**4 Format**

4.1 There may be two A division races followed by two B races.

4.2 No boat rotation.

**5 Courses**

5.1 Apex 2 Reaching start, sail downwind to the weather gate, continue downwind to the leeward gate, round and return to the top gate, finish left.

5.2 Apex 3 Same as Apex 2 but with three legs finishing through bottom gate.

5.3 Apex 4 Same as Apex 2 but twice around or four legs.

6 Larks built in 2016 by Whitecap Composites are beautiful; keep them that way.

**7 Safety**

Each boat shall be rigged with a flashlight taped to the mast, illuminating the jib. Competitors are encouraged to bring personal flashlights and/or glow sticks. Whistles are **STRONGLY** encouraged for all competitors, and shall not be used except in a man overboard situation or other emergency.

**8 Facility**

No gear bags on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

**9. Food**

Food **WILL NOT** be provided this year. Competitors are encouraged to order pizza.
