Question #1: Can sailors use lazy sheets and control lines for the purpose of hiking? If Yes, ignore other questions.

Question #2: What lines can be used to hike off of? If yes or no answers are needed, continue to next questions.

Question #3: Can sailors use traveler control line to hike off of for straight line or maneuvers?

Question #4: Can sailors use Vang control line to hike off of for straight line or maneuvers?

Question #5: Can Sailors use Twings to hike off of for straight line or maneuvers?

Question #6: Can Sailors use halyards to hike off of for straight line or maneuvers?
