**Notice of Race**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1** The racing will be governed by the rules of sailing as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the Melges 24 Class Rules.

**2 FORMAT**

- 2.1** This event will be sailed on Melges 24 boats provided by members of the fleet at Lake Lanier. Each boat will have 4 collegiate sailors and a boat owner, with collegiate sailors crewing and skippering the boat. There will be class instruction and practice in the morning, then racing in the afternoon. 5 races are anticipated.

**3 SCHEDULE**

**3.1** Saturday, November 18

- 10:00am: Meet at LLSC Clubhouse  
11:00am: Move to B dock, visiting teams meet skippers and get an overview on boat setup.  
11:30am: Practice sail  
12:30pm: Racing begins  
4:30pm: Racing ends, pull out and derig boats  
5:00pm: Racing debrief

## **4 ACCOMODATION**

- 4.1** Space is available for either camping out, or sleeping within the LLSC clubhouse. Teams are responsible for bringing their own camping gear, or sleeping mats/air mattresses and sleeping bags. Teams are asked not to bring alcoholic beverages or other substances not appropriate for high school students to the clubhouse, as a high school regatta will also be using the space.
