# November 9-10, 2024 Notice of Race

# 1. RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the current Intercollegiate Sailing Association (ICSA) Procedural Rules (PR), The Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, the ICSA Singlehanded Championship Conditions and General Championship Conditions, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.1 and 63.2 shall not apply.
- **1.3.** ICSA is the Organizing Authority
- 1.4. ICSA PR 32 will apply.
- **1.5**. PR 22 b) i. is deleted.

# 2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 Selection of Competitors will be by ICSA Championship Selection Procedures.

# 3. REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE

- **3.1.** The Entry Fee is \$115 per competitor payable to the ICSA during online registration.
- **3.2.** Eligible schools / sailors must enter by submitting an official online entry form andmaking payment.
- 3.3. The entry deadline is October 30, 2024

# 4. EQIUPMENT

- **4.1** The Janet Lutz Trophy will be raced in ILCA 6. The Glenn S Foster Trophy will be raced in ILCA 7. All boats will be through mandatory charter through the official supplier: ZIM Sailing.
- **4.2.** Class legal ILCA 6 & 7 equipment shall be used.
- **4.3.** OA provided sails shall be used.
- 4.4. OA Provided spars (masts and booms) shall be used.
- **4.5**. Blades, tillers & extensions, and line packages are to be provided by each competitor. Blades may be chartered through ZIM Sailing for an additional fee.

- **4.7.** ILCA Class legal electronic or analog compasses are permitted. This changes Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules 7.2
- 4.8. Boats will not be rotated.

**10.1.** Coaching may only take place from shore, or an OA provided boat.

# 11. PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

**11.1.** By entering the Championships competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the races and/or using the host's facilities and they consent to taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication, and republication of

such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name or not, without compensation and without competitor approval of such images or any use thereof. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment.

# 12. DRONES / UAVs

**12.1**.Drone operation is prohibited by anyone other than the Organizing Authority or media partners in the race area on November 9th and 10th, 2024.
