

Navy Sailing On Water Medical Emergency Procedure

To be performed by vessel with an injury

- Call the Coach R/C (PRO) on Channel _____
- Describe the injury
- Identify your vessel and location (lower sails, wave, and talk in by VHF)
- Have fenders at the ready
- Provide a crewmember to escort victim aboard support boat (**ensure you take wallets, IDs and cell phones for victim and escorting individual**)

To be performed by the Coach R/C (PRO)

Dispatch the closest and fastest support vessel to the vessel with the injury

- Call the USNA Ambulance at 410-293-3333 describe the emergency and ask for an ambulance to meet the injured at any of the agreed upon locations: **Robert Crown Center** floating dock, **Annapolis City Dock**.
- **Immediately** call the Navy Sailing Duty Officer (NSDO) at 443- 871- 2330 and inform them to the nature of the injury and that the injured is being taken to one of the above locations, they can arrange for a boat pick up if needed.
- CALL USCG Station Annapolis on VHF channel 16 and inform them of the situation and to where you are taking the injured person. Identify transport boat, current location with estimated ETA at the one of the above locations.

To be performed by the vessel attending to the injured sailor

- Call the Coach, R/C PRO and inform them of the nature of the injured and that you have them on board and to where you are taking them. Secure injured for a fast transport to the dock
- Continue to update above until the victim is in the hands of a medical professional
- Do not take the injured to the hospital / doctor yourself
