Sailing Instructions

1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing and the ICSA Procedural Rules.

2. Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board upstairs.

3. Schedule of Racing

Saturday Report time	1030
Competitors Meeting	1045
First warning signal	1100
Sunday Report time	0930
No Start After (Sunday)	1500

4. Format

4.1 Rotation will occur every 2 races, with A division sailing first.

5. The Course

5.1 The standard course will be W4 with windward offset and leeward gate.

5.2 W6 may be used to meet target race length in an east or west wind.

5.3 If a windward finish can expedite rotations, a W3 or W5 may be used.

6. Marks

All turning marks are mast buoys displaying red flags.

7. The Start

Races will be started using Appendix Q, Sound Signal Starting System.

The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the RC boat and mast buoy displaying an orange flag to port of the RC boat.

8. The Finish

The finishing line will be between an orange flag on the RC boat and a mast buoy displaying an orange flag to starboard of the RC boat. For windward finishes, a separate RC boat and finish pin will be set to windward of the top marks.

9. Protests

Protest forms are available on the table next to the RP forms. Protests shall be filed with the scorekeeper within 30 minutes of the end of any round-robin or sail-off round.
