



## 2025 Triangle Tango Intercollegiate Regatta

November 8-9, 2025

Lake Crabtree, Morrisville, NC

### Sailing Instructions

#### 1. Rules

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)

1.2. RRS 26 will be changed to a three-minute whistle start.

1.3. RRS 44.1 will be modified such that a boat is only required to complete a One-Turn Penalty after she breaks one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while racing.

#### 2. Notices to Competitors

2.1. Notices to competitors will be issued at the opening ceremony/skipper's meeting on Saturday morning.

#### 3. Changes to Sailing Instructions

3.1. Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1000 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

#### 4. Signals Made Ashore

4.1. Signals made ashore will not be applicable at this event.

#### 5. Class Flags

5.1. There will be no class flag flown from the committee boat because only FJs are being sailed in this event.

#### 6. The Courses

6.1. No later than the warning signal, the race committee will inform any changes to the racecourse orally ensuring all participants confirm receipt.

6.2. The course diagrams are displayed in the pages following the Sailing Instructions. They show the courses, the order in which that marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left

#### 7. Marks

7.1. Marks will be round orange-red marks or will otherwise be identified at the skippers' meeting



## 8. The Start

8.1. Races will be started by using the three-minute collegiate horn start sequence established in SI 1.2

8.2. The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee vessel and the course side of the starting mark

## 9. Change of the Next Leg of the Course

9.1. To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will lay a new mark (or move the finishing line) and remove the original mark is replaced, it will be replaced by an original mark.

## 10. The Finish

10.1. The finish line will be the starting line.

## 11. Time Limits

11.1. Any given race will be called abandoned when the time parameters below are exceeded

- Mark 1 Time Limit: 10 minutes
- Time limit for first boat to finish: 25 minutes
- Time limit for any boat after the first boat to finish: 10 minutes

11.2. Boats failing to finish within the Finishing Window shall be scored Did Not Finish or Finished in Place at the discretion of the Race Committee without hearing. This changes RRs 35, A4, and A5.

## 12. Protests and Requests for Redress

12.1. Protest forms are available at the official notice board. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there within the appropriate time limit

12.2. For each class, the protest time limit is 60 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later

12.3. Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings will be held.

12.4. Notices of protests by the race committee, technical committee, or protest committee will be posted to inform boats under RRS 61.1 (b)



12.5. On the last scheduled day of racing a request for redress based on a protest committee decision shall be delivered no later than 30 minutes after the decision was posted. This changes RRS 62.2.
