

CLUB RULES FOR VISITING YACHTSMAN AND GUESTS

North Cape Yacht Club is a family centric club that welcomes visitors. We hope all of our guests find their experience here to be both pleasurable and memorable. While visiting, we ask our guests to follow the same rules that we request of our members.

- All guests using the facilities of the Club must treat them as their own.
- Members and their families often sleep on their boats; therefore, on-board parties making appreciable noise must retire to the Club House at 2300 hours
- NCYC is a family club. Objectionable language is not tolerable at any time.
- Members and guests must be in presentable attire when entering the club house. Members and guests may not enter Club House in bathing suits or minus shoes.
- Members and guests are requested to leave the restrooms in a clean and orderly appearance. Good housekeeping is necessary in order to maintain a respectable appearance.
- The bringing of intoxicating liquors into the Club House or onto the back patio is prohibited. All rules of the Michigan State Liquor Commission will be strictly adhered to and enforced
- All members and guests using the beach or club grounds must clean trash and litter after picnics or parties and place in trash containers. No glass containers will be allowed on the beach.
- All people must refrain from throwing any cans, bottles, or other refuse in the lagoon or lake. Trash containers are provided for that purpose
- Barbeque grills will be allowed in the picnic areas, beach and on the grounds. If hot coals remain, they should be placed in the

permanent grills for disposal.

- Open fires are not permitted except on the beach in designated areas.
- Dogs, cats, and other domestic animals are not permitted on club grounds
- Fireworks are forbidden on the Club premises.
