1 RULES

2 SERIES AND FORMAT

The regatta will consist of three complete round robins of seven flights. Each team's boat color will be assigned in tech score for Saturday and additional boat assignments shall be drawn for. There will be no other boat rotation among different teams unless determined by the RC. Format may be modified by RC depending on progress and temps

6 PROTESTS, JURY, AND PROCEDURE SYSTEM

7 COACH BOATS AND COACHING

Coach Boats will be made available to one coach per team and coaching will be allowed on the water between races. Dress warmly! We expect to return to the dock after Flight 3 of each day for warm-up, bathroom, and quick snack break. Expedited hearings might also take place for any accumulated protests.
