- 3.1. The format for the regatta is as follows:
 - 3.1.1. Round 1 Round robin of all twelve teams.
 - 3.1.2. Round 2 Round robin of the top eight teams after Round 1.
 - 3.1.3. Round 3 Round robin of the top six teams after Round 2.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Sailing Instructions will be available on Tech Score and posted on the Official Notice Board.

5. NEISA REPRESENTATIVE

5.1. Matt Lindblad (MIT) will serve as the NEISA Representative.

6. BOATS & EQUIPMENT

6.1. 24 2013 Laser Performance FJs will be provided for all competitors.

7. SAFETY

7.1. At the discretion of the Regatta Chairman, dry suits may be required. Notice will be given orally and on the Official Notice Board on the morning of each day of competition.

8. COACHING

8.1. PR 19 will apply. Coaches will be on land.

9. COMPETITOR ONLY ZONE

9.1. The second floor of Jacobs Rock and all floating docks will be Competitor Only Zones. Allowed in these zones will be competitors, coaches, officials, and CGA staff only. Signs will direct other regatta attendees to spectating locations.

10. WATER AND WATER BOTTLES

10.1. The water at Jacobs Rock is non-potable. Competitors should bring their own reusable water bottles and larger quantity containers for re-filling.
