Guidance for Regatta Day Operation - Sailing 4/10/21

All events will follow Medical Guidance for ICSA Competition.

VISITING TEAM INFORMATION:

- Temp Checks for visiting team
 - Recommended Temp Check completed by ATC prior to leaving their campus.
 - o If Temp check cannot occur prior to departure, a Temp Check can occur on arrival Must be pre-arranged with CGA.
- Except for team specific bathrooms and changing rooms, it is our intention to host this event entirely outside and on the water. There will be designated spaces for teams and support personnel.
 - A plan indicating assigned boats, bathrooms, and team space will be sent to visiting teams prior to arrival at CGA.
- Face coverings are mandatory for all individuals.
- Rigging and launching will be staggered to ensure only one team is on each dock at a time. Competitors will only
 have access to their assigned dock.

VISITING TEAM ARRIVAL AT CGA:

- Team bus/vehicle will be met and escorted to the waterfront.
- Show the visiting team the one-way traffic patterns and where the bathrooms are located.

RACE OFFICIALS:

- Temperature checks of race officials will be prearranged with CGA.
- Race officials will have separate bathrooms and changing facilities from competitors and coaches.
- Race officials will receive their own motorboat which will be docked away from coach and competitor launching area.
- Officials will practice social distancing at all times.
- Face coverings will be required at all times.

RACING PROTOCOLS:

- Face coverings are mandatory for all individuals.
 - Includes coaches, student athletes on the sidelines, officials, & game administrators.
 - Masks will be worn by all athletes while competing.
- To the greatest extent practicable, all sailors and coaches will stay socially distant from rival schools when on land.
- Sailors will not rotate boats.
- Separate water coolers will be provided for every team. All athletes are responsible for bringing their own water bottles.
- Boats shall dock only at assigned locations.
- Except for emergencies, all repairs and assistance to boats will be made by individual team's coaches to mitigate team to team interactions.

SPECTATORS:

No spectators will be allowed.

4/10/21 Plan

URI, SRU, and Tufts will be hosted at CGA and CC will host BC, Stanford, and RWU. Teams will meet on the water for competition.

Race committee will be staffed by CGA sailors/coaches for Dinghy races and CGA sailors/coaches for J70 races. All RC individuals will be in the same testing protocol as sailors.

This weekend we will be limiting indoor space unless we have inclement weather. Teams should be prepared to only have indoor access to bathrooms.

URI will be assigned to Pine Hall Bathrooms

SRU and Tufts will have access to Jacob's Rock second floor bathrooms.

One-way traffic will flow as follows:

- Entering the building: Using the Main entrance and the main staircase to the second floor.
- Exiting the building: Using Porch staircase or back staircase to riverside of Jacob's Rock

Non-CGA sailors will not be allowed in coaches' offices, or in any rooms on the first floor including workshop and silo.

Only one team is allowed to be on a dock at a time unless they are actively departing the dock. Teams may have to wait in the basin for another team to finish derigging before returning to the dock.

CGA FJs will be located on the southern dock

Tufts FJs will be located on the eastern dinghy dock, east side of dock.

SRU FJs will be located on the eastern dinghy dock, west side of dock

URI FJs will be located on the western dinghy dock (closest to land)

URI J70s will be located on the Leadership dock.
