# **GUIDANCE FOR REGATTA DAY OPERATION - 3/27/21**

All events will follow Medical Guidance for ICSA Competition.

## VISITING TEAM INFORMATION:

• Temp Checks for visiting team

o Recommended Temp Check completed by ATC prior to leaving their campus.

o If Temp check cannot occur prior to departure, a Temp Check can occur on arrival.

• Except for team specific bathrooms and changing areas, it is our intention to host this event entirely outside and on the water.

- o URI will have a bathroom and changing space on the lower level of the Bready Sailing Center. URI will use the bathroom to the right off the boat storage area. Traffic will flow as follows:
  - Entering/Exiting the building: URI will use the ajar garage door on the lower level.
- RWU will be in the classroom space upstairs. They will enter through the mid-level entrance and proceed up the stairs. They will utilized the bathroom on the roof deck.
  URI sailors will not be allowed in coaches' offices or in any rooms on the mid-level.
- Face coverings are mandatory for all individuals.

• Rigging and launching will be staggered to ensure only one team is on each dock at a time as diagrammed below (where RWU is light blue and URI is navy blue). URI will rig and launch first, then RWU can rig and launch. A few boats will launch from land.

#### **RACING PROTOCOLS:**

- Face coverings are mandatory for all individuals.
  - o Includes coaches, student athletes on the sidelines, officials, & game administrators.
  - o Masks will be worn by all athletes while competing.

• To the greatest extent practicable, all sailors and coaches will stay socially distant from visiting schools when on land.

- Sailors will not rotate boats.
- Boats shall dock only at assigned locations.

• Except for emergencies, all repairs and assistance to boats will be made by individual team's coaches to mitigate team to team interactions.

#### **SPECTATORS:**

• No spectators are allowed

# RACE COMMITTEE:

RC will be staffed by RWU sailors and coaches. All RC individuals will be in the same testing protocol as sailors.

## **RIGGING AND DERIGGING:**

- Rigging: Sails and tillers will be in the boats before they arrive.
- Deigging: After sailing, teams will be staggered in returning sails and tillers to the boat storage area.

# **SKIPPERS MEETING NOTES**

**Channel/Current:** Be aware of the shipping channel. Occasionally there is commercial traffic. It gets really deep in the middle and there is a lot of current: High on Sat. 7:41am, low 1:22PM **Warnings:** Do not sail far from the float toward the shore, there are big rocks there.

*Courses and Course Area*: See the board. <u>Fleet Racing Note</u> the gate mark that is not part of the start, but is part of the finish. Marks are orange balls. We'll try to race as close and conveniently to the learning platform as possible, but realistically go where ever the best breeze is.

*Lunch Break:* We didn't schedule a lunch break, but we'll take a staggered break between team racing and fleet racing for bathroom and snack needs.

**Parking:** YOU <u>CAN NOT</u> PARK IN THE DRIVEWAY TO THE SAILING CENTER. <u>Parking</u> is available at the waterfront where ever you can find space, but keep the walking path and the beach clear. The spots along Bayside (Lot 13) are fair game. Otherwise you can park in the lot behind the mail room (Lot 11 & 12).

Sails and sail bags: Please tie the sail bags to the dock.

*Docks:* Watch your step on the sailing float. It's easy to fall through.

*Water bottle filler:* There is only one water bottle filler which will be off limits to visiting teams, so please bring water.

*Rudder Tie Ins:* You will not get redress if you capsize and your rudder falls out of the boat. Please make sure it is tied in.

*MNS:* We share the waterfront with Marine and Natural Sciences, please be respectful of their gear in the water and on the dock.

**Protests:** Please read Appendix G in the Procedural Rules.

*Drysuits:* All competitors MAY be required to wear drysuits or wetsuits while on the water. That call will be made shortly after report time. The water temperature is 39 degrees.
