## COVID POLICIES FOR INTERCOLLEGIATE EVENTS AT ECKERD COLLEGE

Participants and non-participants may be on-site at the Doyle Sailing Center during event hours but must promptly leave campus at the end of each day's event. Attendance and IDs will be checked at the front gate and Eckerd College has the authority to remove affiliated participants and non-participants who are not in compliance.

The College may need to implement stricter COVID protocols at any or all scheduled contests based on the percentage of positivity rates within the United States, the State of Florida, Pinellas County or any surrounding counties.

- The protocols that the College may implement include, but are not limited to:
  - reduced attendance for all or any portion of the Event;
  - o required masking for all non-participants in the Doyle Sailing Center or surrounding area
  - increased disinfection protocols for all common space areas at the Doyle Sailing Center (at the sole expense of the lessee)
  - Protocols suggested by the Pinellas County Health Department
  - Protocols suggested by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) or the National Institutes of Health (NIH)
  - o Protocols suggested by the American College Health Association.
  - o Protocols suggested by the Florida Department of Health
- The User will notify Eckerd College's athletic administrators of any instance in which a participating party has tested positive for Covid19.
- If a positive case is reported and confirmed it may take up to 24 hours for appropriate cleaning measures to be enacted. Any additional cleaning costs that result from a positive test by an Event participant, spectator or official or an employee, contractor, or representative of User would be absorbed by the User.
- If school is in session and a positive case is confirmed, Eckerd College also reserves the right to restrict fan and participant movement to the Doyle Sailing Center and surrounding parking areas. No driving or walking tours of the campus would be allowed if this circumstance arises.
