1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Rules, and the sailing instructions.

First start Saturday 1120

No Saturday start after 1800

Note: the boathouse will not open before 1000 for early arrivals on Saturday.

3 Sailing Instructions will be available via Tech Score by Friday

4 Format

"A" division will start with two races, followed by "B" division, alternating throughout.

5 Courses

5.1 Course 4 will be the standard course (W-L-W-L with windward offset and leeward gate)

5.2 Course 6 is also a possibility

5.3 Course G (Gold Cup Course) will be triangle-W-L

6 Larks, built in 2016 by Whitecap Composites are beautiful; keep them that way. Adjusting the shroud pins between races is permitted except that no spare clevis pins and cotter rings will be supplied if you lose any.

7 Protests

7.1 Forms are available in the office and must be filled during the first offset after the incident.

7.2 Protests will be heard in the Boat Bays.

8 Prizes for all is the opportunity to sail the coolest boats in all of college sailing.

9 Boathouse Use

The Observation deck is open, but competitors are not allowed in the building except to use the restrooms.
