NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

ENTRY

Only one team per school is allowed. There is no entry fee. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements.

LOCATION

Boats will sail from the CMA boat basin. Racing will occur in Morrow Cove immediately adjacent to the CMA campus. Spectating is available over the entire campus waterfront.

The GPS address is 200 Maritime Academy Drive, Vallejo CA. Drive all the way down the hill and follow the waterfront for parking.

BOAT BASIN/DOCKS

The CMA docks and parking area are considered a secure port facility. Dollies and trailers can be parked inside the gate, but no cars. Only competitors and coaches are allowed inside. All personnel must be escorted by a CMA cadet or staff, and may be asked to provide identification.

BOATS and SAILS

There will be no charters. CMA can provide a limited number of FJs at no cost based on need. Teams must provide their own PCCSC legal sails. Local Bay Area teams, and teams that are able to are asked to bring their own. If your school requires a boat contact Tom Tucker.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be made available on TechScore the week prior to the regatta and on site upon arrival on Saturday.

COACHING

Limited coach boats will be available. Coaches will be asked to carry a radio and may need to assist on the water.

FORMAT

This will be a two-division regatta with one entry per school. Teams will remain in their boat for the entire regatta. Divisions will rotate every two races. Rotations will occur on the docks inside the boat basin.

LUNCH

Burgers/hot dogs will be available both days for racers and coaches. There will be a grill manned by CMA cadets on the waterfront lawn. The CMA dining hall is on campus adjacent to the waterfront and open for racers and spectators.
