



Island Cup Team Race

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the ICSA Procedural Rules, the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-24 (including Appendix D, team racing rules), the prescriptions of US sailing, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race.
- 1.2. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the check-in table Saturday morning.
- 1.3. There will be two certified umpires for this event, each in a powerboat with an assistant.
- 1.4. This regatta includes alumni teams, who will not be a part of the official scores on Techscore.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1. All PCCSC Regular or Provisional Member Schools in good standing are eligible to sail, along with any invited alumni from PCCSC schools.
- 2.2. There are no limits to the number of teams a school may bring. Each team shall consist of six or more currently eligible sailors or alumni. A team consisting of both current team members and alumni is permitted, but will be scored as an alumni team and therefore will not be on Techscore.

3. REGISTRATION & FEES

- 3.1. All teams must RSVP via the PCCSC Regatta Matrix no later than April 10, 2023.
- 3.2. All alumni must submit the Alumni Sign Up Form, distributed to teams via email, no later than April 10, 2023.
- 3.3. An entry fee of \$20 per college sailor and \$25 per alumni sailor will be collected via the Sail Orcas online waiver and payment system. The link will be sent via email after registration via Regatta Matrix or Alumni Sign Up is completed.
- 3.4. Housing is not provided by WWU or Sail Orcas without request.
- 3.5. Please find housing and make a ferry reservation ASAP.

4. BOATS & FORMAT

- 4.1. The regatta will be hosted in FJs. Attending teams may be asked to provide boats, sails, and blades depending on the number of teams that sign up.
- 4.2. In the event that boats from off-island are needed, teams that do not bring boats will be asked to pay a \$50 charter fee per team for the weekend.
- 4.3. This is a team race event. Team races will be 3 vs 3. 18 boats will constitute 3 flights. The race committee will work hard to complete as many rotations as possible.

No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, distilled spirits), or use any controlled substance (marijuana, cocaine, etc.), the possession of which is unlawful. An alleged breach of this rule and/or other disciplinary matters that occur may be the basis for a hearing under rule 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing will be the Principal Race Officer (PRO) of the regatta along with the Race Committee and umpires.
