

MAISA Women's Team Race Conference Championships

Cornell University April 15-16, 2023 Sailing Instructions



RULES

This regatta will be governed by the current version of the Racing Rules of Sailing (2021-2024), including Appendix D, the Procedural Rules for Intercollegiate Sailing Competition (2021-2024), and the Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, except as any of these are modified by these sailing instructions.

- 1.1 RRS D4.3(b) is changed to "However, if a round robin is terminated, its race results shall not be included unless they are included as results in a round that replaces the terminated round, but shall be used to break ties between teams in the group who all sailed each other in the terminated round robin.
- 2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices will be posted on the official regatta notice board located online on Techscore.

3 CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes in the sailing instructions will be announced orally and posted before the first race in which they are to take effect.

5 FORMAT

- 5.1 3 rounds will be attempted. ICSA Procedural rules to apply for breaking ties.
- 5.2 If in the opinion of the Regatta Host and the ICSA Rep the proposed format cannot be completed in time, the number of rounds may be reduced.
- 5.3 One full round robin must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 5.4 Incomplete rounds will not be included in the final scores, but may be used to break ties. RRS Appendix D4.2b is deleted.
- 5.5 Scores shall carry forward from each round.

6 BOATS & EQUIPMENT

- 6.1 White cap 420 or FJ will be provided for all competitors, who shall not modify any boat or cause them to be modified in any way. Competitors have the option of rigging the main sheet purchase either 3:1 or 4:1.
- 6.2 The standing rigging shall not be adjusted.
- 6.3 The penalty for infringing instruction 6.1 or 6.2 will be disqualification from all races sailed in contravention of those instructions.
- 6.4 Competitors shall report all damage or loss of equipment, however slight, to the dock/Finish Boat immediately after finishing or to the Race Committee Signal Boat on the water.
- 6.5 Breakdowns will be decided using PR 20, and RRS Appendix D. Breakdown consideration will not be given for the failure of knots (except at the head of the main when it was determined there was not an opportunity to check it), or loss of cotter pins and rings.

7 ROTATION

The rotation of boats will be in accordance with the rotation listed on Techscore. Boat exchanges will occur at Cornell's marina floating dock. Specific instructions will be given after each round and by the Dock Master.

RACING AREA

The racing area will be Cayuga Lake.

MARKS

9 Starting and Finish Marks will be Yellow Balls. Marks 1,2,3,4 will be Red balls.

- 10 COURSES
- 10.1 The Course will be the standard ICSA Starboard Digital N and will be displayed on the Official Notice Board.
- 10.2 The starting and finishing lines will be between a staff from which a flag is displayed and the course side of a Yellow ball.

11 STARTING SYSTEM

Races will be started in accordance with PR 18(b)(iii).

12 RECALLS

12.1 Individual recalls will be signaled in accordance with PR 18(b)(iv).

13 PROTESTS

13.1 Protests will follow RRS Section A, as amended by Appendix D, and modified by ICSA PR Appendix G for Expedited Hearings. Coaches shall serve as the Umpires.

13 Drones

Drones may be used, however all Federal and Local laws/rules must be followed. Any footage must be shared to all teams competing.

- 15 SCORING
- 15.1 RRS D3 and D4 shall be used, as modified by PR 25.
- 15.2 Breakdowns will be scored in accordance with RRS D.5 as changed by PR 20.

16 SAFETY

- 16.1 Competitors who require assistance from rescue boats should so signify by waving arms overhead. A competitor who retires from a race shall notify the Race Committee as soon as possible.
- 16.2 Starts may not be delayed to accommodate capsized boats

17 COACHING

PR 19 shall apply.
