

1 RULES

- **1.1** The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Intercollegiate Sailing Association in conjunction with the University of Texas at Austin.
- **1.2** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Procedural Rules and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- **1.3** Procedural Rule 32 will be in effect.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **2.1** All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements and have been selected to attend by their Conference Selection Committee.
- **2.2** Entry fee is \$45 payable upon receipt of an invoice from SEISA.

3 SCHEDULE AND FORMAT

3.2 The regatta format will be a double round robin as per ICSA PR 22. A division will start in 420Es and B division will start in FJs.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be made available prior to the Competitors' Meeting and shall be posted on TechScore.

5 RACING AREA

Racing will be conducted on Lake Travis from the Austin Yacht Club.

6 BOATS AND EQUIPMENT

- **6.1** The regatta will be sailed in Collegiate FJs and 420Es. Competitors shall not modify any boat or cause them to be modified in any way, except that competitors have the option of rigging the mainsheet purchase either 3:1 or 4:1.
- **6.2** The standing rigging shall not be adjusted.

7 SPECTATORS AND COACHING

- **7.1** All spectators shall remain 100 yards from competitors while racing. Spectators will receive one warning. The second entrance shall be cause for a protest by the OA against the affiliated team(s) under RRS41 and RRS 60.3d.
- **7.2** Spectator boats must carry a radio and monitor the Race Committee channel.
- **7.3** Spectator boats shall not dock at the rotation dock and spectators shall not enter the rotation area. This is considered a field of play and is only open to registered competitors and their coaches.
- **7.4** At the discretion of the Race Committee, the OA will provide coaches on-the-water access. All coaches should be prepared and bring a PFD.

8 PRACTICE EXCLUSION ZONE

The waters of Lake Travis will be considered an exclusion zone, following the guideline of PR 27.

9 AUSTIN YACHT CLUB RULES

- **9.1** No pets, fireworks, drones, or open fires are allowed on AYC property.
- **9.2** AYC is committed to preventing the spread of the invasive species, zebra mussels, and asks all boat owners (sailboats, motorboats, kayaks, etc.) to clean their bilges and trailers when coming from another lake to Lake Travis, and again when leaving Lake Travis going to another lake.
