COACHING FORMATS

Semifinals

- Coaches and alternates on land for entirety

Finals

- Coaching on water available (conditions dependent) - 1 Coach plus 2 Alternates per Team Afloat MAX
- Use general skeleton from ACC Showcases
 - Rotations on water: 2 sets (4 races) then hard break on shore
 - Dependent on breeze and discussion with PRO/ICSA rep
 - Shuttle available during each rotation for individuals needing to use indoor bathroom

SAILS AND BOATS

Eastern Semifinal: Day 1 420Es, then switch fleets

Western Semifinal: Day 1 FJs, then switch fleets

Finals:

Day 1 - A Division 420Es, B Division FJs

Day 2 – switch fleets

Zim 2018 FJs will be using North Zim Platinum Sails, 2022 with Zim/College sailing logos – same as used in 2022 Nationals.

Zim 2023 420Es will be using North Zim Platinum Sails, 2023 with KP logos.

ON LAND LOGISTICS

- Upon arrival on campus, the driver of each vehicle will need to present photo ID to Campus Security at the Front Gate.
- Each team will receive a packet of **Entry Badges** that will be used for the duration of the event. These will serve as your parking permit for the event and expedite entry during the subsequent days.

Team Parking

- Each team will be pre-assigned a parking spot for one vehicle at the end of Steamboat Rd.
- Teams will proceed down to the end of Steamboat Rd; turn around at the Coast Guard Station, and then park in diagonally on the south side of the road.
- There will be approx. 15-20 additional unassigned spots on Steamboat Rd for teams with more than 1 vehicle. These will be on a first-come first-serve basis.
- Once these are taken, all additional team vehicles will be directed to the Roosevelt Lot adjacent to the baseball field
- Public Safety to be assisting with parking, traffic direction, etc.



Team Parking: RED

Each team will have one reserved spot, plus additional overflow parking for teams with two vehicles.

Regatta Management & Parking: PINK

Waterfront staff and event staff will have access to USCG lot, Yocum Sailing Center Lot, Yocum Sailing Center street parking.

Accessibility Parking: BLUE

Handicap spots located at Yocum Sailing Center, on south side of building.

Spectator Parking: OFF MAP

General parking for event spectators will be available at the Roosevelt field lot.

Team Sections & Tents

- No teams will be able to set up inside of the Yocum or on the Upstairs Pavilion
- Each team will be pre-assigned a 15' x 10' section on Mallory pier for Semifinals
- Teams can set up shade tents, chairs, etc.
- If teams bring tents, we ask teams bring spare line, water jugs, etc. to weight down the corners as they will be set up on a concrete substrate and not able to be staked.
- There will be also a large Event Tent set up adjacent to the Eldridge Pool.

VIP Welcome Briefing

- There will be a Welcome Briefing at the Event Tent from VIP and the Academy Administration to all competitors and spectators in the morning at the beginning of each Nationals (0900-0905 May 23)

Zone of Play

- Everything within confines of Hague Basin (rotation docks, coach boat docks, etc) falling within Zone of Play – only coaches, athletes, race personnel, NO parents/spectators.

- Any spectators who are spectating via water on a personal vessel will not be permitted within Hague Basin at any point.

Restrooms

- Yocum 1st and 2nd Floor Restrooms, two 3-room Restroom trailers, and the Restrooms adjacent to the Elderidge Pool will be open for usage
