**RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Procedural Rules & Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

**ENTRY**

Each school may enter unlimited Open teams. There is a \$50 entry fee per boat payable by check or cash to “UCSC Sailing Club”. Entry fees will be collected at the event. This will be a single division rotational event. **BOATS**

Teams will race PCCSC-legal FJs to be provided by each team. Teams must provide their own PCCSC legal FJ sails. Limited charter boats from UCSC may be available, please contact us at [ucscsail@gmail.com](mailto:ucscsail@gmail.com) for more information. Charter price is \$100 per FJ for the weekend. If you are chartering, you must bring your own race sails. If there is a shortage of charters, schools traveling the largest distances will be given the charters. The final decision on who gets charters is up to the discretion of UCSC Sailing.
