Team Staging: Four 10x10 pop-up tents will be provided for teams to keep belongings in the shade and out of any inclement weather. Teams are welcome to bring their pop-up tents. A grassy area North of the boathouse will be available for teams to set up shop. Good viewing can also be had in the Crow's Nest upstairs at the boat house.

NOTES: Due to the impacts of Hurricane lan, our boathouse is currently closed for renovation. Restrooms will be made available in the art building just North of Alfond Boat House. DO NOT enter with wet sailing gear and please be respectful to ensure these accommodations are made available to us in the future.

DROP OFF – The best place to drop off your sailors is to the left of the Rollins Art Museum at the end of Holt Avenue. To the left of the museum, you will see a wooden walkway that leads down to a clay path along the lake. Follow that path to the Alfond Boat House.
