1. HOST

The event will be hosted by the University of Victoria Sailing Team (UVic) and will be held at Cadboro Bay / Gyro Park.

2. DATES

Saturday the 16th and Sunday the 17th of March 2024.

3. FEES

- a) There is a \$10 registration fee per sailor.
- b) If you choose to charter a boat, there is a \$30 fee per boat and a \$100 damage deposit (per boat).

4. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the current ICSA Procedural Rules, the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of Sail Canada, the Sailing Instructions and Notice of Race.

12. TRAVELING TO VICTORIA

Passports: Passports **ARE** required to enter into Canada by air, land or sea for US or Canadian citizens. Any and all documents must not be expired.

Ferry: It is strongly recommended that all travelers take the BC Ferries on the Tsawwassen-Swartz Bay route to get to Victoria. The BC Ferry runs until 9:00pm, which will allow all sailors to stay until the end of the Regatta on Sunday.
