1. Rules

1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Collegiate Sailing Conference in conjunction with the host, UC Irvine.

1.2. This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements.

2.2. All entrants must pay all entry and charter fees.

2.3. This regatta will have a varsity and a JV fleet, each consisting of 2 divisions. Schools may enter one coed Varsity team, one women's Varsity team, and unlimited Junior Varsity teams. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements. Teams shall confirm their participation via the PCCSC live schedule by April 18th.

3. ENTRY FEES

3.1. Entry Fee is \$50 per boat and will be due by competitors meeting at 10:00 a.m. Fees can be paid via cash, check or Venmo to @Spencer-Eldridge-10. Let us know at check-in if you need a receipt. Each team entered is responsible for providing PCCSC-legal sails and boats.

4. CHARTERS

4.1. A limited number of charters are available for \$160. Further teams will be prioritized for charters.

All teams chartering a boat must bring their own rudders/tillers and sails. Please reach out to sailingclub@uci.edu for charters as soon as possible. Charters can be paid via cash, check, or Venmo to @Spencer-Eldridge-10.

6. PARKING AND BOAT STORAGE

6.1. Parking is free on the street approaching the yacht club, but limited. There is a parking lot directly across from the yacht club you may park in, it is **NOT** free parking. **No vehicle parking is permitted within the yacht club.** You can store boats and trailers overnight within the yacht club in the designated area close to the wall. UCI will help with parking trailers and boats Friday and Saturday. If teams plan to drop trailers off on Friday **please contact us in advance** for access to the yacht club.

7. COMPETITOR'S MEETING AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. The competitor's meeting will be held at 1000 on Saturday, April 25th at the ABYC launch ramp. The Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the competitors' meeting via Whatsapp and linked in the heading of this Notice of Race.

8. RACING AREA/LAUNCHING

- 8.1. The racing area will be the Alamitos Bay Turning Basin.
- 8.2. Launching – Alamitos Bay Yacht Club launch ramp for initial launching.
- 8.3. Rotations – will take place on the public beach adjacent to the yacht club.

9. COACHING

9.1. All coaching should be done from shore. Any spectators on the water shall have no contact with any competitor except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, or as instructed by the Race Committee. Coaches are not allowed on the water.

10. SCORING

10.1. Low point scoring system will be used in accordance with ICSA Procedural Rules.

11. Respecting the Yacht Club Space

11.1. Please respect the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club. We are sharing this space with the ABYC members. They are making it possible for the Anteater Open to happen this year. Keep that in mind and keep the space clean so we are able to use this space again.
