RULES

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the ICSA Procedural Rules & Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

ENTRY

Each school may enter unlimited Open and Women's teams. There is a \$50 entry fee per boat payable by zelle, check or cash to "UCSD Sailing". Entry fees will be collected at the event. This will be a 2 division rotational event. If you cannot pay by zelle, check or cash, please contact Thomas Murphy. (tnmurphy@ucsd.edu).

Schools must confirm their attendance and the number of boats by 10:15 on Saturday, January 17th, 2026 to the PCCSC Regatta Sign-Up Google Doc.

BOATS

Teams will race PCCSC-legal FJs to be provided by each team. Teams must provide their own PCCSC legal FJ sails and dollies. Sails will be provided to all boats in the Women's division. Limited charter boats from MBYC may be available, please contact Brendan O'Connor (b2oconnor@ucsd.edu) for information. Charter price is \$150 per FJ for the weekend. If you are chartering, you must bring your own race sails except if you are in the women's division. If there is a shortage of charters, schools traveling the largest distances and women's teams will be given the charters. The final decision on who gets charters is up to the discretion of UCSD Sailing and MBYC.

The regatta shall be sailed on the waters of Mission Bay.

COURSES

A Course Chart will be provided with the Sailing Instructions and will describe the marks and courses, the order in which marks are to be rounded or passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

SCORING

The scoring system will follow the ICSA procedural rules. Separate women's regattas (multiple if possible) and an open-gender regatta shall be scored concurrently. Depending on the number of entries, the women's fleet may start with the open fleet or have their own separate start but sail the same course.


HOUSING

FACILITIES

- You must rotate off of the Junior Dock.
- Visiting teams are welcome to use the picnic tables on the beach or set up chairs along the grass at the north end of the property. Please leave the tables on the concrete deck open for members to use during the day
- There is limited parking outside of Mission Bay Yacht Club. Please carpool and park outside if at all possible. There is street parking on El Carmel Pl outside of the Yacht Club.
- Boats will be stored at Mission Bay Yacht Club.
- Bathrooms are located at the Junior Clubhouse.
- Picnic tables with umbrellas are available. Please be respectful of MBYC members using the picnic tables and other amenities.

- No dogs are allowed on MBYC property
- Please treat the MBYC facilities with respect. If a trash can is full, please put your trash in another receptacle; there are cans in the picnic area, the boat yard, and at the entrance of the main club building. There is also a dumpster at the gate.
