

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Collegiate Sailing Conference in conjunction with host Cal Poly SLO.
- 1.2. This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3. RRS D2.2 and D2.3 shall be used (as changed by the ICSA Procedural and Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements
- 2.2. Charter and entry fees are \$100 due by competitors meeting at 10:00 a.m. on March 8th.
- 2.3. Entry is due on the PCCSC Live Schedule sheet by 1 week prior to the event
- 2.4. Entry fee payable by cash, Zelle, or check to "Cal Poly ASI Club Sports" with "Sailing Team" in memo line
- 2.5. To request an invoice please contact cpsailing@gmail.com

3. BOATS & SAILS

- 3.1. 12 FJs and 12 sets of sails shall be provided by Cal Poly. Competitors shall not modify any boat or cause them to be modified in any way other than choosing to rig main sheets either 3:1 or 4:1.
- 3.2. The standing rigging shall not be adjusted.
- 3.3. The penalty for infringing instruction 4.1 or 4.2 will be disqualification from all races sailed in contravention of those instructions.
- 3.4. Competitors shall report all damage or loss of equipment, however slight, to the Race Committee or Finish Boat.

5. FORMAT & ROTATIONS

5.1. The format shall be a double round-robin between all teams present. Sailoffs shall be conducted to eliminate any ties.

- 5.1.1 Round Robin 1- all teams
- 5.1.2 Round Robin 2-all teams
- 5.1.3 Sailoffs- tied teams

5.2. Rotations will be posted and available at the competitors meeting

6. COMPETITOR'S MEETING AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The competitors meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, February 1st on the first floor deck of Morro Bay Yacht Club. The Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the competitors' meeting.

7. RACING AREA/LAUNCHING

7.1. The regatta will be sailed out of the Morro Bay Yacht Club. The intended racing area will be the south basin of Morro Bay. Rotations will be held off the public dock. Racing location is weather and tide permitting.

7.2. Launching will occur at the Morro Bay Yacht Club, using the MBYC crane.

8. COACHING

All coaching should be done from the public dock. Any spectators on the water shall have no contact with any competitor except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, or as instructed by the Race Committee. Coaches are not allowed on the water.

9. SCORING

Low point scoring system will be used in accordance with ICSA Procedural Rules.

10. HOUSING

Please contact cpsailing@gmail.com if you are looking for housing. MBYC members and Cal Poly team members have generously offered to provide housing for sailors, however housing is limited. The deadline to request housing is February 28th.

11. PARKING AND BOAT STORAGE

Parking is free everywhere surrounding the yacht club but limited. There is a free parking lot in front of a large tin quonset hut, directly across from the yacht club. Boats shall be stored on the MBYC tarmac on dollies overnight.
