1. **RULES** This regatta will be governed by the current version of the Racing Rules of Sailing (2025-2028), including Appendix D, and the prescriptions of US SAILING; and the Procedural Rules, except as any of these are modified by these sailing instructions.

2. **NOTICES TO COMPETITORS** Notices will be posted on the rolling white board and electronically on the Tech Score notice board as soon as possible thereafter.

3. **CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** Any changes in the sailing instructions will be announced orally and posted as soon as practicable.

5. **FORMAT** The format of the regatta will be a triple round robin

6. **BOATS & EQUIPMENT** Collegiate Dinghy 420's will be provided for competitors, who shall not modify any boat or cause them to be modified in any way. Competitors have the option of rigging the mainsheet purchase either 3:1 or 4:1. The standing rigging shall not be adjusted. Competitors shall report any damage or loss of equipment, however slight, to a member of the Race Committee on the water or immediately after arriving ashore.

7. **ROTATION.** The rotation of boats will be posted in Techscore.

8. **THE COURSE** The course will be a Digital N. Rounding marks will be orange marks.

9. **START/FINISH.** 3 Minute Dinghy Start.

10. **PROTESTS** Protests shall be filed in accordance with the ICSA Procedural Rules with the following change. "Race Committee" in PR 29(b) is changed to "Race Committee Finish Boat." Written protests, including requests for redress and breakdowns, shall be filed with the organizing authority within 30 minutes of the last competitor's arrival ashore after the race or set of races in which the incident occurred (Modifies PR 30). 3. 10.3. PR 32 shall be in effect.

11. **SAFETY** Competitors who require assistance from rescue boats should signify so by waving arms overhead. A competitor who retires from a race shall notify the Race Committee as soon as possible.

12. **COACHING** PCR 19 will apply.. The pier and floating docks shall be considered "Field of Play" areas which are restricted to team members only including any team staJ, coaches, facility staJ, race officials, and regatta organizers. Coaches may be asked to help umpire.
