#### RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 (RRS), the ICSA Procedural Rules (PR) and Class Rules, and SAISA Rules and Regulations.
- 1.2 RRS Appendix D will be in effect.

- 2.1 Notices will be posted online via the Techscore Regatta Notice Board.

#### CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Any changes in the sailing instructions before the event's start date will be posted to the Notice Board via amendment on Techscore.
- 3.2 Any other changes in the sailing instructions will be communicated verbally at the competitor's meeting or thereafter through the Organizing Authority and the ICSA Rep.

#### FORMAT

- 5.1 Three Round Robins will be attempted. If not completed, racing will resume on Sunday, February 22, 2026.
- 5.2 The OA will consult the ICSA representative regarding any changes to the format.

#### BOATS & EQUIPMENT

- 6.1 (18) FJ's will be provided and shall not be modified in any way.
- 6.2 The standing rigging shall not be adjusted.
- 6.3 The penalty for infringing instruction 6.1 or 6.2 will be disqualification from all races sailed in contravention of those instructions.
- 6.4 Competitors shall report all damage or loss of equipment, however slight, to the PRO, dock staff, Race Committee, or Finish Boat.

#### ROTATION

- 7.1 The rotation of boats will be in accordance with the rotation available online at [scores.collegesailing.org](http://scores.collegesailing.org)

## MARKS

8.1 All rounding marks will be orange balls.

8.2 The start line will be between a large orange ball and a blue flag displayed on the Race Committee start boat.

8.3 The finish line will be between a white ball and a blue flag displayed on the Race Committee Finish boat.

## COURSE

9.1 Courses will be a Digital N

## STARTING SYSTEM

10.1 Races will be started in accordance with PR 18(b)(i).

## RECALLS

11.1 Individual recalls will be signaled in accordance with Procedural Rule 18(b)(ii).

## SAFETY

12.1 Competitors who require assistance from rescue boats should signify by waving their arms overhead.

12.2 A competitor who retires from a race shall notify the RC as soon as possible.

12.3 Starts will not be delayed to accommodate capsized boats.
